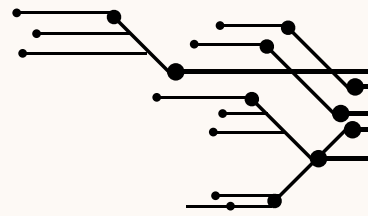


## *Taking the Learning Outdoors*



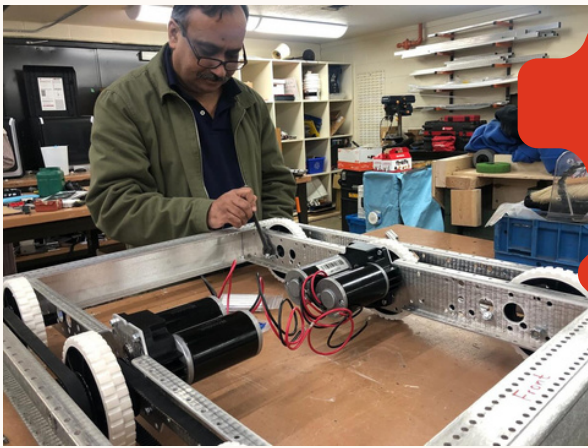
Grade 9 students are learning Islamic Studies and enjoying the sunshine through discussions in outdoor educational circles with Ms. Mariam!

# Ramadan at WIHS



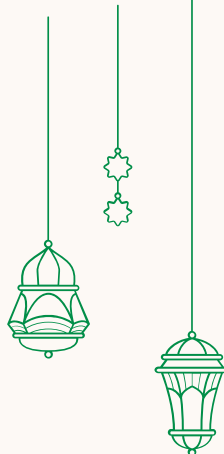
Students prepared for Ramadan with a halaqa by Imam Omar Al-Ani from AlBerr Mosque. Jazak Allahu khairan!

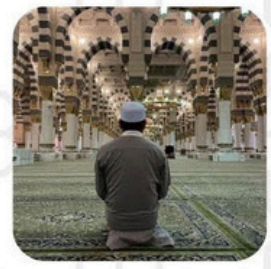

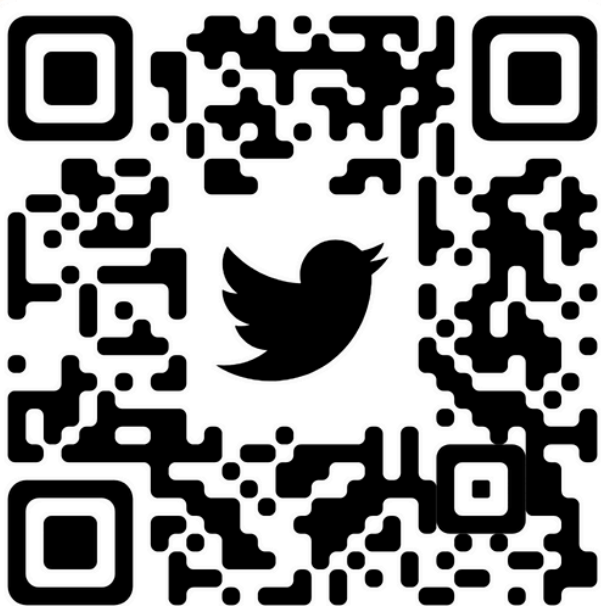
